2018 Goals of the LEC

A successful, volunteer-driven lodge doesn't just appear and maintain itself – We need YOU to help us out!

- 1) By Dec 13, 2017, the Troop Rep Chairman will have an OA troop roster with OA rep. contact information 75% identified.
- **2)** By May 2018, Round Table will attain an average of 40% troop rep. attendance- for both Dubuque and Dellaykee Districts.
- 3) By Fall Fellowship 2018, the LEC will average 8 LEC participates at Lodge events.
- 4) Publish a Talking Leaf the months of November, January, March, May, July.
- 5) Have the OA Secretary write meeting minutes for each monthly LEC meeting and have them published to various places (website, email, etc.) by the next LEC meeting. Also, have hard copies of the minutes to be reviewed at the monthly LEC meeting.
- 6) Have the OA Treasurer update the treasury report at each monthly LEC meeting and inquires on any additional updated funds needed.
- **7)** By March 2018, the Lodge will have 175 dues paying members through previous actions taken.
- **8)** After Fall Fellowship, have at least 80% of the OA members full paid due members (amount needed for JTE).
- **9)** By February 2018 LEC meeting, identify 5 Elangomat and 5 Nimat guides and have training at TWA.
- 10) Within 1 month of completing the Ordeal/Brotherhood weekend, the Elangomat and Nimat guides will submit their Clan members to the secretary for entry into the computer. Contact made when needed.
- 11) Our Lodge will achieve JTE gold in 2017.
- **12)** Achieve quorum at a minimum of 50% of LEC meetings.
- **13)** Have a preliminary meeting before TWA to check with ceremony members and have a dress rehearsal at TWA. Have two more dress rehearsals before Spring Fellowship.

On the weekend of October 13 - 15, members of the LEC came together to adjust to their new roles within the Lodge, undergo training to ensure a successful year for Timmeu, plan for a full year of

activities and events, and experience fellowship. But that's not all there is to Lodge Leadership Development.

- And as always, please make sure you are up-to-date on dues.




