



## Job Description: Field Sports Director

**Essential Functions:** The Field Sports Director is responsible for the safe operation of the Shooting Sports program at Camp. The Shooting Sports Director must possess sound, mature judgment and personal integrity. In addition, the Director must possess a strong commitment to working with youth of Boy Scout age. The Field Sports Director must be 21 and comply with NCAP Standards.

- Maintain safe .22 caliber rifle, archery, and shotgun ranges.
- Enforcing the safety regulations of the BSA and NRA.
- Immediately report any individuals who are unwilling to abide by the safety policies of the NRA and BSA
- Instructing Scouts in marksmanship skills as outlined by the BSA and NRA.
- Assisting unit leaders in recognizing the shooting sports program opportunities available to them both in and out of Camp.
- Reporting inadequacies in inventory and equipment
- Work to obtain a thorough knowledge of the BSA's Shooting Sports Program.
- Working to maintain the morale of those Staff members assigned to shooting sports.
- Prepare of the end-of-season report.
- All other duties assigned
