



Job Description: Pe@k Director

Essential Functions: The Pe@k Director is the representative of the Older boy program and must report to the Program Director at all times. The Pe@k director must have the ability to work with older scouts and unit leaders. The Pe@k director must be cheerful, sincere, tactful, creative, and above all strongly motivated by the Scouting program

- Responsible for the entire Pe@k program which includes promotion and participation of mountain biking on high adventure trails, facilitating of mountain boarding, off site treks, paddle boarding and other designated to the Pe@k activities.
- Help coordinate both a Pe@k program with the Program Director.
- Supervise and direct Pe@k staff as to their specific responsibilities.
- All B.S.A. safety requirements will be promoted, followed, and taught.
- Keep records of all advancement and hand them into the Program Director.
- Maintain accurate inventory records.
- Run the provisional scout program as set up by the Program committee.
- Assisting in the general Camp program in anyway possible, and completing any assignments given by the Program Director or the Camp Director
- Working to maintain the morale of other Staff members assigned to the Pe@k program.
- All other duties as assigned to him/her by the Camp Director.
